I could not get up onto my feet after many strenuous tries, and I ended up having to crawl on my hands and knees all the way back to my car. End result was 2 back operations, Lumbar and Thoracic, this year and I still have trouble walking and standing. I have not been able to fly since August of 2017.

If I had had my cell phone on me, rather than in the car I could have called for help. So make sure you have your cell phone with all the time.
