Flying Fields


Mike is back from Florida and he has mowed both flying fields. The grass was very high and it may take a few cuttings to get it really cut well.

Treasurer's Report May, 2020

Hope all are staying healthy. The best way to approach this report is a year to date summary covering January through April activity.

Collections for the 4 months total \$5,733.00 represented by Dues \$5,600, Applications \$50 Fifty/Fifty \$18 and a Donation \$65.

Spending so far totals \$772.10 represented by AMA \$280, Andover Borough, Room rental \$200, NJ –Lease \$135, Christmas Part Food \$106.60, NJ – Annual Report \$30.50, IRS Form 990N filing fee \$20 resulting in and ending bank balance of \$12,051.81

This year remains to be a tight budget year even with the delayed start to the flying season. After mowing and porta jons we will be looking to our cash reserves to cover any remaining general operating expenses.
