Best Scale Jet at Florida Jets 2021

Florida Jets is the world's largest event for the professional radio control jet pilots. There are four great days of nonstop R/C Jet action with planes that operate with real turbine jet engines. Some of these jets are ten foot long and fly up to 200mph.

Florida Jets took place at Paradise Field on the south side of the Lakeland Linder International Airport on March 17-20. It's not a competition, but more like a fly-in with sponsors presenting several awards for excellence in several categories.

One of the awards given was for Best Scale Jet. Scott Geller received that award for a replica of the A-10 Warthog. The plane was detailed right down to every rivet, panel line, and nomenclature, which took over 400 hours to create.

The airframe was from MIBO Jets and it is 1/5.8 scale. The wingspan is 118 inches and the fuselage is 108 inches long and the weight was over 70 pounds. The plane was powered by two JetCat P-180's producing of 42 lbs of thrust each. For control, Scott used the PowerBox Core radio and the PowerBox Royal using PowerBox Pro batteries.

Detailing the model included realistic lighting by Unilight providing five freely programmable light sequences. The pilot was purchased from Tailored Pilots with a realistic fabric jumpsuit and scale helmet. Behind that helmet as indicated in the aircraft is none other than Captain Billy Reynolds. The Snow Camouflage paint and decals were obtained from Tailor Made Decals specifically for the MIBO 1/5.8 A-10. They were applied with precision by Scott and then a final clear coat was applied. Starting with stock MIBO ordnance, extra details were added to make them more realistic.

Overall – a Great Job and an award well deserved.
