


February 2022

Treasurer's Report February 2022

We ended 2021 with a positive balance of \$605 bringing our total cash balance to \$7,746.69.

For 2021 we overspent on mowing, offset by lower spending on field maintenance. We also canceled the Porta Jons on month early and received an additional reduction to the bill of \$96 for the poor service we had at Reynolds Field during the year.


2022 beginning reserves are as follows:

General Reserve:	\$2,746
Event Reserve:	2,000
Reynolds Field Reserve:	3,000
Total	\$7,746

For January, we received \$2,510 represented by Dues \$2,310 and Donations \$200. Expenditures totaled \$415 represented by AMA Charter \$280 and State of NJ – Reynolds Field \$135 resulting in an ending bank balance of \$9,841.69

At the February, I talked about some products I recently purchased that the membership might find useful. Below is a servo harness which simplifies the attachment of wings. There are many on the market, but this is the one I purchased.

Another item I brought in was a fuel tank from Fourtitude R/C. All the plumbing was pre cut and all you have to do is assemble it. It is more reliable than other tanks. Each tank includes the needed plumbing with Exceleon Fuel Line, Walbro Double Filtered Clunk, Molded Nylon vent and fill tubes, Velcro brand mounting tape, and

foam mounting pad.

I talked in length about replacing the retracts in my Hanger 9 Corsair. I replaced the troublesome mechanical ones with electric one from eFlite. They way they rotate was far better than the ones I had installed. Check them out.
