# March 17, 2022 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:30. Mike and Tony were absent. There were a total of 7 members in attendance.

Minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's Report. March's opening balance was \$9,481.69. After March's activity, the ending balance is \$12,263.19. A full report is in the newsletter. It was stated that last year's spending was just under \$7,000 against an \$8,000 budget. So far this year we have \$4,517 to spend on annual operating expenses. There are sufficient reserves to carry us through the year but unless we can grow the club or find a way to bring additional funds into the treasury, we will be facing a dues increase in 2023.

We discussed ways to attract members and will start putting together school contact information and consider hosting some open house activities during the early season.

A work party was brought up for Reynolds Field. Any weed mowing needs to take place by April 15<sup>th</sup> per the State. Unfortunately, there was insufficient attendance to set a date.

We had a lively discussion concerning the number of meetings we could have a year and where they should take place. There was a general consensus that meetings at the fields should be extended to 4 and would perhaps encourage flying and increased attendance. They would take place in May, June, July and August. There was also a suggestion that one or some meetings could be held on a weekend.

Some like the current monthly schedule stating that it is on the third Thursday of every month and easy to remember. It was pointed out that with email it is now easier to remind members of meeting schedules on a regular basis.

One schedule discussed was for meeting at the Senior Center in January, April, September and November and meetings at the field in May, June, July and August. All with the caveat that additional meetings could always be scheduled if needed.

There were no motions passed and this will be discussed further at the April meeting
