Converting Glow to Electric

At the last meeting I did a show-andtell talking about a delta ARF that I completed recently. I had the plane for a long time and it was slated for an OS .46. I seriously thought about converting it to electric and did a good amount of research.

I was looking at two configurations. The first was an 820kv motor with a 60 amp ESC, a 5 cell 4000 MAH battery swinging a 11x7 prop. The second was a little more robust – an 780kv motor with an 80 amp ESC, a 5 cell 5000 MAH battery swinging a 12x6 prop. I came across a chart that helped me with the choices. I will attach the chart when I mail out the newsletter.

I decided against the electric conversion realistically thinking how often I may fly the plane against the cost. Besides, I probably will sell it anyway. But it was a good exercise and now I have another plane to sell at the Lebanon Flea Market if I do decide to sell it!
