# **October 2022 Meeting Minutes**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM. Craig was absent. There were 11 members at the meeting. The minutes from the previous meet were read and approved without correction.

Treasures Report: None. Craig was absent and did not send one in.

Fields: Both fields are in good flying shape. At Hardyston, follow the safety protocol is a plane goes down on the farmers property and you have to retrieve it.

Membership: There was a moment of silence for the passing of a long-time member – John Kassatkin.

Safety: There are hunters around each of our fields so beware. Also, there is a bear constantly at Hardyston, so be again be aware.

Old Business: Nominations for club officers was opened up again. No new nominations were made. For next month's election, we have the slate proposed by the current officers. The slate is Pat Rizzuto for President, John Morgan for Vice President, Anthony Curcuruto for Secretary and Craig Miebach for Treasurer. Frank Costello was nominated last month for Vice President.

New Business: The combination for the lock at Hardyston will be changed to match the one at Reynolds. It will be done after January and after all members paid their dues. Mowing — since Mike Shauger is moving to Florida, we are losing our mowing contractor. Frank Fanelli will be mowing Hardyston. We need five volunteers for Reynolds to mow five times each. Compensation will be free membership for the year. A motion was made and approved to purchase Mike's mower for \$500. A motion was made and approved to upgrade Mike to Life Member.

At the end of the meeting, Anthony made a presentation on a new *foamie* he put together and talked about its pitfalls.

#### Field Chairman Needed for Both Fields

Field chairmans are needed for both fields. The responsibility are:

- Assure the field is mowed each week. If the designated mower is not available make sure a substitute is assigned. The field chairman can be the designated mower
- Schedule and manage several work parties as needed. Recommendation is that a work party is scheduled for the first week in June and the first week in August
- Attend to other issues at the field as needed

## Mowing at Reynolds Field

The club is looking for five volunteers to mow Reynolds Field. Each volunteer would mow the field five times. The incentive or compensation is that the volunteers would not have to pay dues. One volunteer would serve as the lead and manage the schedule for the others. The lead would also be responsible for finding a place to secure the mower. The adjacent church would be a good choice (they have a shed that might be of use) offering a donation of maximum of \$200. Also, the lead would have to store the mower over the winter. Leaving the mower at the field is not viable. It would be subject to theft, vandalism, and destruction caused by mice.

This proposal will only work if the church houses the mower during the cutting season and a place, is secured during the winter for the mower.

Cost savings:

Mowing cost for 25 cuts = \$1875 Mowing by volunteers = \$375 The club will be saving \$1575
