

# After the Meeting

At the end of each meeting, we usually have some sort of presentation. After the November meeting, Craig Miebach brought in and talked about a plane that he has been working on for some time.

The plane he brough in was a Cessna 195. It is going to be powered by a DLE 40. The finished plane will look like the photo below. You can see the size of it in the other photos

Craig did a lot of the fabrication for a lot of the features on the plane and talked in detail about it. Craig built the plane from plans, covered it with Dacron, and filled the weave with Evercoat Easy sand. I hope he brings the finished plane to one of our summer meetings.







In order to renew your Recreational Flyer registration, all you need to do is login <u>here</u> and proceed to the recreational flyer dashboard. You will see the link to renew just below your registration number.

When you initially registered, we did not request any aircraft information. Now you will see that there are no devices currently listed in your inventory. We ask that you add at least one device by clicking the blue oval button.

When you get to the question asking if your drone has remote ID question, answer appropriately (go <u>here</u> to see if your drone has an FAA-approved Declaration of Compliance for remote ID).

If the device you enter is a standard remote ID aircraft, enter the remote ID serial number. If the device is a remote ID broadcast-only module, enter the module's serial number and list all aircraft that will fly with that module.

If the device is an aircraft not equipped with remote ID, the serial number is N/A. Below is what I added:
