From the Mayor

At the last meeting there was some discussion regarding a desire to utilize some of the Reynolds Field Reserve to fix the road and repair the area near the windsock in order to grow better grass there.

Regarding the road: Because of the topography and the crop activity along the road, there will be continuing erosion and pot hole type issues. It IS a dirt road. Only a major drainage fix would prevent this. The work Mike Powers and his son have done recently at their own expense and time has the road in pretty decent condition. With the increase in the monsoon type of rainstorms we have seen lately, repairs will be needed again in the future and if they're done voluntarily, great. If not, or should there be a major repair needed, utilization of the reserve would be warranted.

Regarding the area near the windsock: This sparsely grassed and weedy area has become a favorite spot for take offs of the many smaller planes that are prone to noseovers in the grassy areas of the field.

Members should know that a motion to spend money on a proposal can be made during any meeting and should show how it benefits the club or a majority of the members. For a motion to be put on the meeting agenda, it has to be sent to the club secretary at least a week in advance to make sure it holds merit. An estimate/budget should be provided for the proposed item or project and what affect it will have on the club's reserves — now and in the future. If it requires work, what is the plan to do it/have it done, and when? If the cost or work involved is significant, a notice to all of the members is warranted via email or the newsletter before a vote to approve is taken.

With the current member count, all of our income is spent on mowing, AMA fees, field rent, meeting rent, and government fees. We need to be very rigorous in our utilization of our reserves so if a major expenditure should be needed, we'll be able to cover it.
