Product Recommendation

A friend from another club that knew I have a few foam planes told me about this product - Foam Finish Gloss or Matte. Saw it at Tower Hobbies.

Brush these highly adhesive resins onto foam models to improve appearance, surface toughness and protect vulnerable foam skin from damage. May be used with glass cloth for an even tougher surface. They will also seal trim, decals and most paints and are overpaintable once dry. These resins require no mixing, have little or no odor and will keep your models looking like new for longer.
